

RISE Delaware™: Legislative Update for June 15, 2024

House Bills 375, 376, and 377 (cost reduction to accompany the funding of HB 330) will be considered in the Senate Executive Committee on Tuesday, June 18 at 3:00 PM in the Senate Chamber. All three bills were unanimously passed by the House of Representatives on June 13.

House Bill 330 (budget set-aside for retiree healthcare funding) was released from the House Administration Committee on June 12 and reassigned to the House Appropriations Committee on June 13. It will be considered by the Appropriations Committee on Thursday, June 20, at 1:00 PM in the JFC Hearing Room.

House Bills 281 and 282 (guaranteeing Medicfill to retirees and requiring SEBC transparency) have already been passed by the House and Senate and are ready for action by the governor.

House Bill 350 (hospital cost containment) has already been signed by the governor.
